But our family has always known her as Jane Perry, because my Dad always talked about 'the Perry twins' Jean and Jane. When we lived on Louisville Road in the 60's and 70's, Jane and Clarence would let Carolyn come down to play with me in our back yard sometimes, I remember swinging on the swing with her. Jane was a wonderful Mother, Grandmother, Sister, and Daughter. She never met a stranger, once a friend always a friend.

Jane and I shared a bond because we have both lost sons. She comforted me many times and I felt very close to her. The last time I saw her was in January, and wish I had visited again before the Covid restrictions kept us away from the facility. Jane was always sharp and kept her wits about her, she was well-read and knew about current events. When my mom Ramona was in FC&R, Jane would come down to the South hall and visit her. Jane always cared about others and if she knew someone decades ago and had not seen them in that long, she still would talk with them like they had spoken yesterday. She was a model of friendliness and a genuine, real person who treated everyone like a brother or sister.

Remember this is not the end, you will see her again where there are no more tears or pain.
