



Adam Bray Hyatt

Services for Adam Bray Hyatt, 38, of Frankfort, will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday at Buck Run Baptist Church, with Philip Meade and Ricky Simpson officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens. Visitation will be from 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Friday at the church.

Adam died Sunday at the University of Tennessee Medical Center in Knoxville. A native of Versailles, he taught history at Franklin County High School, where he was a sponsor of the Beta Club and loved announcing the football and basketball games.

Outside of school, he had fun fishing, playing disc golf, coaching little league baseball and eating tacos from TT's Tacos and Tortas, owned by one of his former students. Adam was a member of Graefenburg Baptist Church, where he taught Sunday School for many years and worked with the youth. He was also a member of the Pi Kappa Phi Fraternity at Queens University in Charlotte, North Carolina.

He is survived by his wife, Kari Arthur Hyatt; son, James Daryl Hyatt; daughter, Rebekah Ray Hyatt; mother, Susan Bray Hyatt; sister, April Michelle Hyatt; brothers, Jonathan (Kelley) Scott and Jeremy Scott; nieces, Lillie Greenwell and Kaydence Scott; step-parents, Rick and Diana Woodside; grandmothers, Doris Hyatt, Inez Hyatt, and Nellie Hearn; and a multitude of aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.
