Annie Lee Webster, 88, formerly of Frankfort, passed away peacefully in her sleep, on February 2, 2024. She was the youngest child born to the late Elmer and Mae (Wainscott) Webster of the Duckers community in Woodford County, Kentucky.

Annie spent thirty-two years working for the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the Revenue Cabinet. Although Annie loved calling Kentucky home, in 2021, she moved to Blowing Rock, North Carolina to be closer to the great-nieces who were in charge of her care. Lori and Tara loved having her so close. She enjoyed many outings exploring the mountains, driving along the Blue Ridge Parkway, or lunch and shopping with her great-great niece, Chloe.
