



Blane "Scott" Hawkins

March 1, 1943 - September 10, 2019

Blane "Scott" Hawkins, 76, husband of Helen Hawkins, passed away on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. Scott was born in Monroe, Louisiana on March 1, 1943, to the late Clark and Sue Hawkins. He moved with his family to Monterey, Kentucky and then to Frankfort at the age of fourteen. Scott began his career and Roll Farming Corp. and Central Screw before going to work as Machine Shop teacher at the Franklin County Vocational School. After several years he left that position to start his own company and in 1973, Capital City Tool, Inc. was established.

Scott is survived by his wife, Helen, of Frankfort; daughter, Julie Hanus, of Frankfort; son, Blane (Chasta) Hawkins, of Louisville; sister, Vonda Hancock; brothers, James and Gregory Hawkins; and grandchildren, Evan Hanus, Aspen and Levi Hawkins.

In addition to his love for his family, friends, and work, Scott's passions included antique cars, antique guns, and most of all, boating. His greatest and most memorable times were those spent on the waters with his wife traveling up and down the rivers and intercoastal waterways from Kentucky to Florida Gulf coast.
