Throughout her career she taught English, French, Drama, Speech and Theatre. She was even a cheerleading coach at Warren East High School. Some of her best teachings were life lessons. She even did some modeling, she rode on a motorcycle to Sturgis, she was always having fun. She was active in garden clubs, Le Jardinier in Frankfort, Kentucky and most recently the Seagrove

Garden Club in Florida. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Frankfort and had been attending Point Washington United Methodist, in Santa Rosa Beach, Florida.

She truly enjoyed giving and doing for others. She loved feeding people; everyone was welcome at her table. She was always busy, the best storyteller, wonderful cook, amazing mother, wife, daughter and friend. If you were lucky enough to know her then you were fortunate enough to be loved by her. In her most recent years, she moved south to Florida to be with her daughter and son-in-law. Her life was a life well lived; she is home now.
