



## Charles Roe Early

February 27, 1937 - February 28, 2025

Charles Roe Early, devoted husband, loving father, and cherished grandfather, passed away peacefully at his home in Graefenburg, KY on Friday, February 28, 2025, at the age of 88. Born on February 27, 1937, in Shelbyville, KY, he was the son of John Clarence and Nancy Gray Early of Bagdad, KY, who preceded him in death.
