Mr. Jackson was a graduate of Georgetown College and received a Masters of Education from ECU and a Master of Divinity from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He was a classroom teacher at Meade County High School. He pastored many churches beginning at the Brandenburg Baptist Church, 17 years at Oneida Baptist institute including 10 years as President. He was retired from 19 years of service at the Ky Dept. of Education including serving as Director for the Division of Dropout Prevention and Alternative Education. He served 10 years on the Ky Baptist Christian Education Committee and 11 years as trustee of the Southern Baptist Convention Sunday School Board. He was a long time member of Immanuel Baptist Church where he served as deacon.
