Ms. Vivian made Sock-It-To-Me birthday cakes for the girls' birthdays and she made the best bean salad. Ms. Shirley made all the homemade biscuits and gravy and one time she even made chocolate gravy fro all of us. Though we worked very hard we had a very good time sharing stories, crafts, food and recipes. The men would make chili, soups, fry fresh fish - one time they brought in deer chili - Ms. Joyce wasn't too sure about that...She shared with us all the stories about the famous Flynn's restaurant (now closed) that's where she bartended at night. Flynn's was the hot social spot for legislators to wheel and deal. Still today I use Ms. Joyce's recipes for her bourbon balls, crème de mint candy and her mom's jam cake. There's not many of us left that remember those good times. Each time I look at new clothes I think of her - she was always dressed beautifully with matching shoes and purse.
