Emma Jean Young Stucker, a loving, devoted, and dedicated mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother passed away Wednesday, May 11, 2016, at her home in Frankfort, Kentucky, after a brief illness. Mrs. Stucker, a native of the St. John's area of Franklin County was the widow of the late Haskell Stucker to whom she was married for sixty-four years and the daughter of the late Landon Bryant Young and Gladys Duncan Young. A graduate of Bald Knob High School, Class of 1940, and Miss Shaw's Secretarial School in 1941, Mrs. Stucker began her professional career as an accountant for Pennington Bakery, worked for thirty years in State Government in various capacities including service as Assistant Director, Department of Personnel, and was appointed Office Manager for School Service. In 1986, she received the Governor's Outstanding Kentuckian Award in recognition of achievements and meritorious service to the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

A woman of unwavering faith, she was the oldest active member of Memorial Baptist Church serving seventy-two years in many capacities from Sunday School teacher of children and adults to Church Treasurer to Personnel Committee Chairperson. Always active in community, Mrs. Stucker was a long-time member of the Frankfort Woman's Club serving in many leadership positions. As secretary of the Franklin County Democratic Committee in the 1960s, she was the motivator and organizer in revitalizing the Franklin County Democratic Woman's Club making this organization the largest and most

influential women's group in the Commonwealth.

Survivors include children, Angela S. Bennett (Glenn), Weddington, NC, and Rod Stucker (Diane), Goodlettsville, TN; grandchildren, Larry Bennett (Janis), Waxhaw, NC, Susan Bostick (Tim), Fort Worth, TX, Keith Stucker (Beth), Louisville, KY, and Jennifer (Tim) Clark, Mt. Juliet, TN; and twelve great-grandchildren. In addition, she is survived by many relatives and devoted friends.

We celebrate Emma Jean Stucker's remarkable life and her influence as she brought good will to her family, neighbors, friends, and those in less-than-fortunate circumstances. Mrs. Stucker lived her life to the fullest and with a vitality of spirit as she mentored many young women in church and in the workplace.
