Floyd G. "Happy" Terrell, 68, passed peacefully at Frankfort Regional Medical Center Wednesday, July 28, 2010, following a long illness. Happy was a life-long resident of Bald Knob.

Happy was a member of Bellepoint Baptist Church. He retired in 1994 from the KY Transportation Cabinet Bridge Office and had over 31 years of service.
