



## Glendora F. Ison

September 9, 1930 - February 23, 2019

Glendora Fields Ison, 88, of Frankfort, died Saturday evening at Frankfort Regional Medical Center. She was born September 9, 1930 in Whitesburg, Kentucky, and was the daughter of the late Lora Combs and William "Bill" Fields. She was reared on her grandfather's farm and loved the beauty and mysteries of nature at a very early age. These memories she cherished throughout her lifetime.

Glendora graduated from Whitesburg High School in 1948 and attended Bowling Green Business University. She worked fifteen years for Kentucky Power Company in Whitesburg. 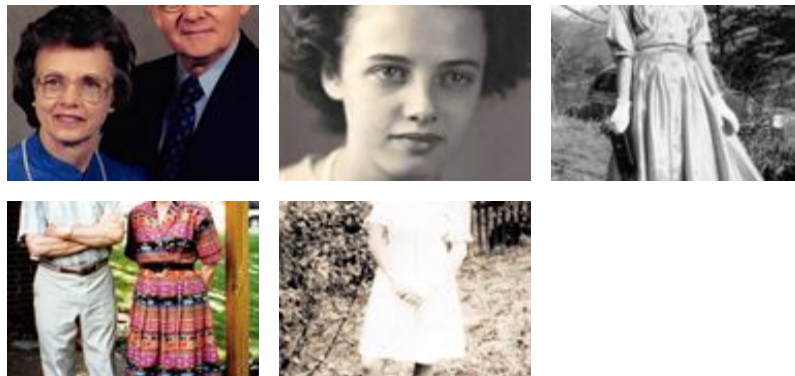
