Helen Virginia (Cecil, Walden) Newton died peacefully in her sleep in the early morning hours of March 17, 2015, in the company of her daughter, Lillian (Walden) Heitkamper in Frankfort, Kentucky. Helen was 92 years old.

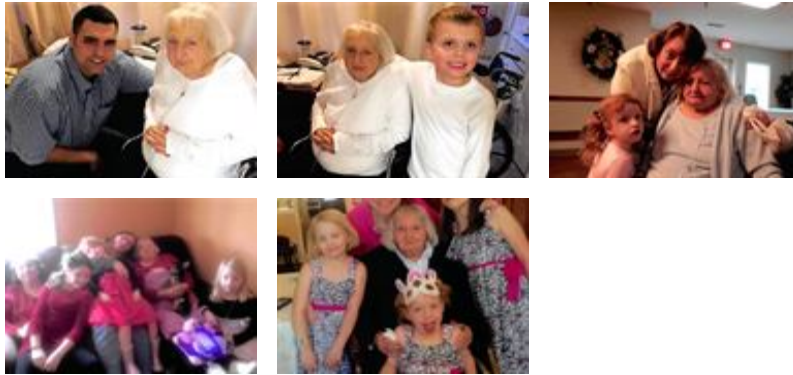
