He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Patricia Crutcher, and thought of as the best husband, dad, and granddaddy. A native of Anderson Co., he was the son of Mazie Brown and John Thomas Crutcher. He was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving in the U.S. Army.
