Jennie Elizabeth Wilson was born February 26, 1973, and died March 3, 2026. She was the daughter of James H. and Carole Elizabeth Wilson; sister of Emily Susan Redmon (Tim) and Harry Lee Wilson.

A 1991 graduate of Franklin County High School, she earned a four-year music scholarship to the University of Kentucky and earned a Bachelor of Arts in Arts Administration. She performed with the U.K. Marching Band and Symphonic Orchestra. One of her fondest memories was performing under the direction of noted composer, conductor, and arranger, Henry Mancini in 1994. She also enjoyed her many relationships with important band directors and fellow, local musical students.

She was an excellent musician having studied piano for several years, a drummer, and the drum major at FCHS. She was an all-state bassoonist for multiple years while in high school culminating in her selection for the Governor's School for the Arts, Class of 1991. During those years, she became an accomplished tennis player.

She was a member of Frankfort's First United Methodist Church, participating in the youth handbell choir at the inauguration of President George Herbert Walker Bush in Washington, D.C. under the musical direction of Roy Nance.
