Larry B. Thomas, 67, of Frankfort, died peacefully at his home on Tuesday, October 7. Visitation will be held at First Presbyterian Church on Friday, October 10 from 9:00-11:30 a.m. Burial services with military honors will be held at Frankfort Cemetery from 12:30 to 1:30 with Witness to the Resurrection worship services following at the church at 2:00 p.m.

Mr. Thomas retired from AT&T with thirty eight years of service as a electronic technician, He was a member of First Presbyterian Church and served in the U.S. Air Force with a tour in Vietnam from 69-70. Mr. Thomas was a talented woodworker who enjoyed many things but the most important accomplishment to him was being a father and grandfather who loved and was loved in return.
