Laura Jean Eads, 48, born in Suffolk County, England, December 20, 1963, died January 15, 2012, at the University of Kentucky Hospital after a lengthy illness.

Laura was a 1982 graduate of Franklin Co. High and attended Eastern Ky University. She was a current employee of the Student Loan Division of Higher Education. She was a member of First United Methodist Church and Bosom Buddies of Franklin Co.
