Funeral Services for Linda Kay Boggess Triplett will be 10:30 A.M. Saturday, March 2, 2024, at Evergreen Baptist Church. Pastor Rick Simpson will be officiating. The burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be 5:00-8:00 P.M. Friday, March 1, 2024, and 9:00-10:30 A.M. Saturday at Evergreen Baptist Church. She passed away on February 27, 2024, at the age of 75, at University of Kentucky Hospice Center Lexington. Linda was born in Frankfort on September 24, 1948.

On May 1, 1987, she married the love of her life Edward Triplett of Frankfort. Linda and Ed spent 36 happy years together doing the things they loved. In addition to taking many cruises to the Caribbean, Linda loved traveling to Pigeon Forge, boating and camping at Lake Cumberland with family and friends. Over the years Linda made many lifelong friends on her traveling adventures with Ed, that she cherished dearly.

As a career, Linda retired from the Cabinet for Health and Family Services. However, her favorite job was working as the Activities Director for Frankfort Apartments, in the old Frankfort Hospital. In addition to her love for seniors, Linda enjoyed other activities like shopping, thrifting, collecting dolls, going out to dinner, singing, spending time with her dog Bella, and talking with family and friends. Linda's greatest love was found in her faith in Christ. Linda was a member of Evergreen Baptist Church where she attended when able, and she enjoyed being a member of the WMU.

Linda was preceded in death by her parents, Paul and Dorothy Boggess and sister, Kathy Paul Boggess. Her legacy includes a son, Jeffery Todd (Beverly) Moore; two daughters, Melissa (Lee) Moore, Jennifer (Scott) Caswell; stepson, Lynn (Mary) Triplett; and stepdaughter, Judy Carol Triplett.
