Mary Eunice Burch Maguire, Lexington, formerly of Frankfort, passed away Saturday morning at Richmond Place in Lexington. Funeral mass will be held Tuesday at 9:00am at the Good Shepherd Catholic Church, 72 Shepherd Way, Frankfort. Father Charles Howell will preside. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens in Frankfort.

Mary Eunice was born in Fancy Farm, KY on June 15, 1920 to the late Samuel Wade and Mary Katherine Elliot Burch. She was preceded in death by all ten of her brothers and sisters. Sadly, she also suffered the loss of her beloved husband Norbert Maguire and cherished daughter Karen Maguire.

Mary Eunice was a long standing and faithful member of the Good Shepherd Catholic Church on Wapping Street where she was active in the Saint Vincent DePaul Society, Altar Society, Women's Auxiliary and the Senior Shepherds. Her working life included caring for children at the Bowl-A-Way's day nursery and sales clerk at Taylor Drugstore before taking a position with the Kentucky Department of Health and Human Resources from which she retired after fifteen years of service.
