Othmar "Joe" Pircher, 71 of Eddyville passed away Monday, March 30, 2015 at Lourdes Hospital in Paducah, KY following a long battle with cancer. Services for Mr. Pircher will be 3 pm Monday, April 06, 2015 at LeCompte, Johnson Taylor Funeral Home. Visitation will be from 3-6 pm with funeral services to be held immediately after visitation.

Mr. Pircher was a retired Chief Warrant Officer 4 veteran of the Kentucky National Guard where he proudly served 33 years. He will be buried at Camp Nelson with military honors.
