Funeral services for Rev. Gayle Daniel "Danny" Williams, 74, will be at 10:00 a. m., Saturday, at First United Methodist Church, 211 Washington Street,

Frankfort. Rev. Wesley Olds and Dr. Wayne Sayre will officiate the services. Burial will be in the Frankfort Cemetery.

Rev. Williams died Wednesday, at the Frankfort Regional Medical Center, of natural causes.

A native of Shelbyville, he was the son of the late Stanley H. and Mary Smither Williams. He was a retired minister of the United Methodist Church, having served churches in, Breman, Perryville, Frankfort, all in Kentucky; and Westfield, OH, and for thirty years, he was minister of the Wesley Foundation at Kentucky State University.

He was a member of the Kentucky Annual Conference of United Methodist

Church and a former Rotarian International member. He was an avid horseman in his youth, riding hunters and jumpers.

He is survived by his wife, Sarah W. Williams, three daughters, Julia (Gary) Davenport, Dayton, OH, Kay (David) Bunning, Ft. Thomas, KY, and Becky (Wes) Olds, Cape Coral, Fl., six grandchildren, Douglas and Amy Davenport, Lou, Laura and Emily Bunning, and Caleb Olds.
