July 31, 1942 - January 17, 2013

Rhenda Kaye Bonner Mills passed away on January 17, 2013 , at the Hospice Center at St Joseph Hospital, Harrodsburg Rd, Lexington, after a 20 year battle with cancer. Mrs. Mills was born on July 31, 1942 in Vanceburg, Lewis County, KY., and was the daughter of the late William "Bill" and Eula B. Parker Bonner, She was affectionately known as "Miss Rhenda" to generations of children, youth, and adults.

Rhenda obtained her Bachelor of Nursing degree from Berea College in 1964 and began work as a Public Health Nurse in Lewis County, KY. When she retired as a public health nurse from the State of Kentucky, she was the State Nurse Epidemiologist. She worked tirelessly to better the health of Kentucky's children. She was a long term member, pianist, and Chancel Choir singer at St. Paul United Methodist Church, Frankfort, and also taught the Little Learners Sunday School Class for decades.

Rhenda married Doyle Mills on June 3, 1978, in Vanceburg, Lewis Co, KY.

In addition to her husband, Rhenda is survived by one son, Cheyenne (Mandy) Mills of Lexington, and one granddaughter, Melody Rose Mills. She is also survived by four brothers and sisters: Dane(Debbie Garrett) Blankenship of Vanceburg, KY; Rebecca (John) Silvey of Vanceburg, KY; Teresa (Tom) Dedman of Georgetown, KY; and Boni Rae (Tom) Lester of Winchester, KY. Funeral services will be held Saturday at 1:30pm, January 19, 2013 at St Paul UMC, Frankfort, KY with the Rev. Elvyn Hamilton officiating. On January 21, 2013, a brief visitation will also be held at Vanceburg UMC, Vanceburg, KY

from 11 am until 2 pm, after which burial will follow in the Black Oak Cemetery, Vanceburg, KY.

Pallbearers will be family and friends. Honorary pallbearers are the St Paul United Methodist Women, and the current and past members of the Little Learners Class.

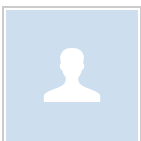
