Ronald Stewart Miller went to his heavenly home Wednesday, March 26, 2025. He was 88 years old. He is survived by his loving wife, Viviane C. Miller, who together traveled to all 50 states including three trips to Alaska. They would have celebrated 69 years of marriage in November.

Ronnie was born in Franklin County on October 21, 1936, by his now deceased parents, Stewart Marshall Miller, Jr. and Edna Mae Robinson Miller. After High School, he worked for Community Service cable company as a lineman and then supervisor. He retired from the Frankfort Electric Water Plant Board in 1994 after 38 years of service. He served six years with the US Army Reserves and was in the first unit of reservists from Central Kentucky. He is well known for his mechanical skills, having restored antique cars and tractors as a hobby. His many friends enjoyed his garage known as "The Toy Box" where they could find answers to their mechanical questions along with fresh coffee. He will be greatly missed by his "garage buddies" Warner, Jerry, Jimmy, John, Bob, Ronnie, Elis and Reid.

He was a member of the Capital Amateur Radio Society. His Ham Radio Call sign was K4NGQ. He was a member of the Frankfort Antique Car Club. He loved his church and church family from Evergreen Baptist Church where he has served as Deacon and Trustee. He was the chief craftsman for their Eastern Kentucky Mission Trips building handicap ramps for those in need. He

has been a member of EBC longer than anyone presently there, as he joined in May, 1951.

Ronnie is also survived by his son, James Stewart (Nanette) Miller; grandson, Kyle Stewart (Bronwyn) Miller; bonus great grandsons, Nolan and Bryson Molohon; great grandson, Cole Stewart Miler; his brother, Gerald (Lee) Miller, of Rock Hill, SC; sister, Ann Watson, of Frankfort; and a whole host of cousins, many nieces and nephews.
