January 31, 1959 - November 29, 2023

Ronnel S. Geveden, 64 of New Albany, IN and Cookeville, TN, passed away peacefully on November 29, 2023, surrounded by his family at the University of Kentucky's Markey Cancer Center in Lexington, KY.

A graduate of Ballard Memorial High School in Ballard County, Ky and the University of Houston, Ron was an 'old soul', selfless and wise beyond his years.
