Mr. Turner died Tuesday at Bradford Square Nursing Home. A native of Scott County, he was born on November 25, 1921, to the late Henry and Ruby Hendricks Turner.

He was a retired farmer, thoroughbred breeder and racing owner, Black Angus breeder, auctioneer and antique dealer. He was a Kentucky Colonel, pioneer farmer, Honorary Commissioner of Agriculture (1996), member of Thoroughbred owner-breeders association and Horsemen's Benevolent Protective Association.

Survivors include a sister, Henrietta Logan; two brothers, Mark (Frances) Turner and Risque (Brenda) Turner, Frankfort; sister-in-law Louise Turner; long-time friend Jackie Branham, all of Frankfort; and several nieces and nephews.
