Funeral services for Steven P. Rucker, 55, will be 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, at Forks of Elkhorn Baptist Church, 495 Duckers Road, Midway, Ky 40347. Rev. Todd Lester will officiate. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens. Visitation will be 4:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m., Monday and 10:00 a.m. until the time of service on Tuesday, at the church.

A Shelbyville native, he resided in Frankfort. Mr. Rucker served as Executive Director of the Kentucky Communications Network Authority (KCNA). Prior to assuming the helm of the KCNA, Mr. Rucker served as Deputy Secretary for the Finance and Administration Cabinet, where he oversaw the Department of Facilities and Support Services, with 5,100 state-owned and leased properties. He has also served in many Information Technology roles for the state government, culminating in his leadership as Commissioner of the Commonwealth Office of Technology.

Mr. Rucker was an avid golfer, dedicated family man, and member of Forks of Elkhorn Baptist Church. He died Thursday at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

Survivors include his loving wife, Marsha Rucker, Frankfort; son, Steven Rucker (Alisha), Lawrenceburg; daughters, Stevi Gottler (Gabe), Frankfort, Jenny Richardson (Paul), Frankfort; four grandchildren, Lucas Gottler, Lyla

Gottler, Gavin Dishon, Stella Richardson; sister, Janey Lewis, Pleasureville; and several nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents, Porter and Corinne Waford Rucker.
