Terrie was a lover of music and the arts, she enjoyed making a joyful noise unto the Lord through her singing. God graced Terrie with a beautiful voice and she was noted for this early in life by the music program of Franklin County High School then later in adulthood singing in the choir and performing countless solos in churches and other singing groups she participated in for decades. She watched movies, spent countless hours playing dolls and cars, read books, told stories, gave invaluable life advice, went swimming and boating, played kickball, and yes even zip lined. The fun, laughter, and love never stopped. And you would never find Gamma missing a birthday party, ballgame, recital, concert, graduation, baptism, or Disney trip. She gave herself willingly again and again so everyone in her family could have life a little better, easier, more fun, more meaningful, and spiritually enriched on a daily basis. Above all, Terrie was a dedicated follower of Jesus Christ, believed in the power of prayer and provided a strong spiritual foundation for her immediate and extended family. She was always very active in the church and was a long-standing member of Graefenburg Baptist Church where her contributions were innumerable. Terrie was an incredible blessing to all that knew her and we know that she is joyous beyond measure to be with the Lord and reunited with her husband and father that she so dearly loved and missed.
