Funeral services for Tom P. Mason, 86, will be 12 noon, Saturday at First Baptist Church, 201 Saint Clair Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601. Dr. Robert Browning will officiate. Burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be 10:00 a.m. until the time of service at the church on Saturday.

A Union County native, he currently resided in Frankfort. He was a dedicated member of First Baptist Church at the Singing Bridge. Of the fifty years he was a member, he was a Chairman of the Deacons, Trustee of the Church, member of the Keystone Sunday School Class, and he taught Sunday School. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge #66 and volunteered at the Soup Kitchen. He was a long time Director of the Division of Right of Way and Utilities for the Transportation Department. He enjoyed coaching Frankfort Youth Baseball and watching sports. He will be remembered as being a consummate grandfather. He proudly served his country as a 1st Lt. in the Army during the Korean Conflict. He received the Korean Service Medal, United Nations Service Medal, Purple Heart, and Bronze Star Medal. He died Thursday at Taylor Manor in Versailles.

Survivors include his loving wife of sixty- two years, Carolyn Brisby Mason, Frankfort; children, Rick Mason (Diane), Frankfort, Clay Mason (Jane), Lawrenceburg, Stephen Mason (Lara), Frankfort; grandchildren, Thomas Cary Mason, Lucas Pryor Mason, Zachary Clay Mason, Marjorie Grace Mason, James Anderson Mason, Hallee Elizabeth Mason, and Stephen Parks Mason.
