Vicki Ann Morgan Sebastian passed into the hands of her Lord the 1st day of July, 2010. Vicki was 59 years of age. She was a registered nurse for 39 years, serving the citizens of Franklin and Shelby counties. Vicki was Director of Nursing from 1975 to 1981 at King's Daughters Hospital in Shelbyville, KY. At the time of her death she was employed as a Certified Case Manager at the Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

She is survived by her husband of 37 years, Darvin Sebastian; daughters, Holly and Kellie and son, Wes.
