He was born in Belle Point, he worked forty-one years as a lab technician for the Transportation Cabinet, a member of Disabled American Veterans and Veterans of Foreign Wars, a member of Graefenburg Christian Church, and he enjoyed deer hunting and working with his goats. Wayne proudly served his country in the Navy during the Cuban Crisis on the USS Newport News/Heavy Cruiser between 1961 and 1965. He died Friday at his residence after a lengthy illness.

He is preceded in death by his parents; Claude Richard and Alma Ruth Peavler Woods and his wife; Mary Alice Woods.
